

PLANNED IMPROVEMENT FOR SCHOOL

Target Areas – North School continues to make AYP and continues to focus on the same target areas by expanding the activities. The target areas at North School are reading and writing as well as the implementation of PBIS and RTI. North has been recognized by the Illinois State Board of Education and the PBIS Network as a fully implementing school.

Within the area of RTI, North School Staff is reviewing Tier 1, 2 & 3 instruction and correlating assessments. The goal is to have a flexible yet coordinated instructional approach that responds to the needs of the students.

Measurable Goals - Each grade level sets formative goals and monitors progress toward the goals at three times a year.

Activities – The activities in the school improvement plan target the goal areas. The staff collects procedural data on the activities as well as student achievement data. All activities are screened using the *Nine Powerful Practices, Nine strategies that help raise the achievement of students living in poverty* by Ruby Payne.

Assessment – The area of assessment is under review at North School. North School is compliant with both State and local assessment programs, but we in the process of implementing AIMS web.

Communication to the Public – The monthly newsletters always begins with a section on school improvement. School Improvement information is shared at PTO meetings as well. Our corporate partner Wheels, Inc. also reviews our SIP Plan.
