Project 2010

Project '10 is an innovative program, designed for bright young learners who welcome fresh opportunities to explore diverse subjects in a challenging, inspiring environment! Project '10 meets on weekdays for three weeks. Students may enroll in either the Morning Program or the Full-Day Program. The development of problem-solving skills, creativity, and critical thinking are inherent in the framework for all courses. Projects and activities evoke active, hands-on participation.

Morning Program: For all students, mornings consist of two classes, chosen by the students themselves from a variety of exciting topics (see inside). One-half to one hour is reserved on some mornings for Colloquium, an informal gathering of the Project students and faculty, which may include class performances, guest presentations, or fiercely fun trivia bowls.

Full-Day Program: The afternoon component of the Full-Day Program provides in-depth, hands-on exploration of a single theme of the student's choice. This immersion into a topic affords each student the privilege of mastering its content. Following their morning classes, students enjoy lunch before they begin their afternoon quests. They bring their own sack lunches, including drinks, that do not require refrigeration.
